CAMP INFORMATION

All camps are designed to provide a fun environment for all ages and skill levels. The beginner to the very advanced player will be challenged according to their experience and ability. The quality staff is comprised of college soccer coaches and players. The NDSU Soccer camps are open to any and all entrants (limited only by number, age, grade level and/or gender).

Day Camp, ages 5-14: Campers will work on technical abilities while incorporating those techniques into fun activities, in which all participants will be challenged within the proper level.

Elite Girls ID Camp: Designed for the highly competitive and serious soccer player who aspires to play in college. This is an overnight camp that is structured in the format of a college preseason and exposes the player to the rigors of the college game.

Goalkeeping: Goalkeepers will be separated for portions of each day for specific goalkeeper activities. Sessions will be run by camp goalkeeping staff.

Teams: Teams are encouraged to attend camp and will be trained as a team.

Facilities: The North Dakota State Dacotah Field, stadium and practice fields at the Ellig Sports Complex will be utilized.
